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True Wisdom Versus Man's Wisdom

There are only two kinds of wisdom in the world, according to scripture: man's wisdom and God's wisdom. Unfortunately, the wisdom of man is today's prevailing guide for most philosophy and practice. The wisdom of man is usually diametrically opposed to the wisdom of God. For instance, consider the human fabrication known as evolution, with its explanation for the origin of man. This theory is built upon man-made science which denies, even attacks the existence of God. The REAL reason men deny the existence of God is not based on intellect or evidence or lack of evidence, but rebellion. If there is a God, then all men must one day face Him and be accountable. Solution to the God problem: get rid of God by denying His existence and offer an alternative for the origin of man and existence of the universe.

After getting rid of the existence of God, the obvious result is moral relativism, followed by lawlessness. 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Get the Good Credit You Deserve...

I recently heard an ad on radio that went something like this: "Tired of being turned down because of late payments, bankruptcy, or no credit record? Then call 1-000-000-0000 and we'll help you repair your credit record so you can GET THE GOOD CREDIT YOU DESERVE." The good credit you **deserve**? If you haven't been paying your bills on time or at all, then you don't **deserve** good credit. Good credit is not something **deserved** by all, or a **right** guaranteed by the constitution or any other document. Good credit is a privilege you EARN by performance. It's like respect: you earn it.

Credit reporting agencies sometimes make mistakes, but they usually report the truth about an individual's record of payment. And that record is what determines whether or not a merchant will decide to let them have merchandise without paying for it on the spot. Plus, when an individual makes poor choices and ends up with more debt than can be paid for, that person certainly does not need some organization "repairing" their credit so they can add more debt onto the pile. They need help, not more credit. But somehow, people think they have "rights" to everything.

This mentality is found from the top to the bottom, from the government which represents the individuals to the individuals themselves. The government thinks it deserves all it takes in taxes and more. Frederic Bastiat, the French economist from the 1800's, said that taxation was legalized plunder(theft) by a government.

People who will not hold a job and be productive, think they deserve to be taken care of by the state, since they have had "bad breaks" in life, whether it be because of poverty, race, ethnic background, class, handicap, or whatever other excuse can be dreamed up. They just weren't given a "fair shake" so they claim.

Then there are those tax paying citizens who think, since they pay so much in taxes(which they usually do) they **deserve** to get a little back any way they can . They cheat and lie to do so. They don't report all earnings, which is lying and stealing. Or they "become disabled", to draw back some of what they have paid in. 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Don't Preach on Hell

Right next to these boxes were other boxes containing 200 sq feet of plastic wrap, also for about \$3.00. Now really, how much more time does it take and how much more difficult is it to tear off a small piece of wrap from the roll? Maybe another two seconds of life. The precut wraps appeal to frivolous people.

The phone company also has a work saving deal for lazy people....for a small fee of course. Notice when you call directory service, after the computer gives your requested number, you are then offered the service of having the number dialed for you for a fee of anywhere from .30 to .50 cents. Does anyone really take advantage of this bargain? Anyone too lazy to hang up and dial the number ought to be charged \$5.00 for their laziness.

Now I believe in working smarter instead of harder if the same results can be accomplished, but too often the philosophy of today is "don't work smart or hard." Don't work at all if possible. Human nature always desires the easy way, and the easy way is not always necessarily wrong, but this mindset can be reflective of a wrong philosophy. We usually pay more for the easy way out, financially and in quality.

There's nothing wrong with work saving devices, but there's nothing wrong with good old fashioned work either. We usually end up paying a higher price to save time, but then don't wisely use the time we have saved. I know it sounds old fashioned, but that "scripture" from the book of Second Opinions is true: an idle mind **is** the devils workshop. A lot of people don't want to work at all, and if they are forced to work, they don't always take pride in their work.

God designed man to work in Eden **before** the fall of man in sin, and then God made work for man more difficult **after** his fall. A strong work ethic should be taught at an early age. The prophet Jeremiah said that it was good for a man to bear the yoke in his youth. Work produces rest, fulfillment, satisfaction and contentment, not to mention a paycheck. Children who are not taught responsibility and how to work become irresponsible adults who expect society and government to provide for their needs.

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Islam and Jihad: Comments on Palestinian Terrorism Part 3

Too often, the real issue of the problem between the Palestinians and Israelis is overlooked or forgotten. The issue of the land and who really owns it is at the forefront, but there is more to the story than land lines. This is more than just a boundary dispute. The problem lies with Muslims who are dedicated to the obliteration of Jews, who are, to them, infidels and must be converted or destroyed. So the jihad is used and justified. Of the main groups that seek to "push the Israelis into the sea" (to use an old Arab quote), one such group even uses the word "jihad": the group, Islamic Jihad... The terrorist bombers are not dying for earthly land but for a heavenly Muslim paradise. the Palestinian Authority wants the land and total control of it, but do not be fooled into thinking this is all they want. They will settle for nothing short of the absence of Jews from the land. Why do you think they have NEVER accepted any land proposal on the table? So coexistence is out of the question. Recently, the Pope said that Palestinians should not be the targets of wholesale retaliation and the Jews should not have to live in fear of bombings every day. He said these two things are obstacles to coexistence.

And Arafat is not even a "Palestinian" but was born in Egypt. So why does he think he has a dog in this fight? Because the issue is not land, as much as it is religion.

The problem is a religion which fosters hate and expands itself by tyranny, force and murder. Murder is promoted by the Palestinian Authority by glorifying the "heroes" who die in jihad. They name schools and summer camps after them. Notice the following:

- (1) The Dalal Al-Mughrabi school is a girls school named after a homicide bomber.
- (2) The Ayyat al-Ahras Camp is named after a Shahid-Seeker or a suicide bomber, this one female.
- (3) The Jihad al-Amarin children's summer camp, sponsored by the Fatah movement, also named after a terrorist
- (4) The Baha Sa'id soccer team, is named after a terrorist.

Glorifying murder before children is inexcusable, but understanding the religion that makes provision for and promotes destructive behavior helps explain why people become fanatical to the point of killing themselves and others. For Islam to be credible and really become the peaceful religion it claims to be, its leaders should renounce jihad totally and completely and Muslim controlled governments should grant liberty and religious tolerance to their citizens. 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Tolerance

Tolerance is the buzz word of the decade. As I look up "toleration" in the dictionary, here is what I find: (1) allowance given to that which is not wholly approved and (2) recognition of the right of private judgment in religion. Look at the first definition.

By being tolerant of something, there is also an admittance that the "something" is not approved, according to the dictionary definition. Tolerance means to allow that which is by definition, not approved. The hot spot of toleration today is concerning homosexuality. The plea for tolerance of homosexuality is a plea to ask for allowances in an area where most do not give approval. But the real plea is not for tolerance. The real issue is acceptance, disguised in the milder clothes of tolerance.

Homosexuality is already tolerated. Homosexuals who are open about their deviance, enjoy an extremely high degree of tolerance. They can hold public office, vote, go to college, own property, rent property, own businesses, flaunt their abomination in public parades, teach in public schools, just to name a few freedoms they enjoy. They already enjoy extreme tolerance. What they want is endorsement and validation of their perverseness, which can then be used as a foothold to declare heterosexuality to be abnormal. Notice, when the homo friendly media and entertainment industry portray homosexuals, they are painted as being brighter, warmer, more compassionate, and more lovable than normal people. Let me repeat myself: homosexuals could not have a higher level of endorsement and tolerance than they now experience. 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How To Hire A Preacher

When it comes to "hiring" a preacher, certain qualifications usually come to mind. Education, experience, and family status are just a few of the criteria used to measure the candidate. Some people are concerned with age: he may be too young or he may be too old. Still, others don't want a boring, teaching preacher, but a dynamic, flamboyant pulpiteer.

I have decided, with all seriousness, that a lot of churches miss the boat when calling a pastor. The premise of **Mini Edition** is that good common sense, guided by Scripture is always the best rule of thumb in every situation. Churches could learn a thing or two about calling a pastor if they would just put aside the resume and references of the candidate and consider another avenue. Character Trait-Goes the second mile. If so, then he will probably work hard and not be slack in his ministry work as your pastor.

(3) When walking down an aisle in the store, does he stop and pick up stray items on the floor and put them back on the shelf or out of the way of traffic? Character Trait-Consideration and a good stewardship. He is considering the safety of other shoppers and helping the store keep items from being destroyed and shop worn.

(4) Is he courteous with other shoppers and workers in the store, including the checkout person? Character Trait-Grace and compassion. If he is rude, pushy, arrogant and impatient, then he lacks graciousness and compassion and will probably give his church members the same treatment.

(5) Does he park in the handicap spot, because "after all, it's empty"? Character trait-Sensitivity. This one speaks for itself. Is he is insensitive to the needs of others, placing his needs first. Need I say more?

Actually, these standards would apply in calling a pastor, hiring an employee in business, or looking for a husband or wife. Be careful. You never know who may be watching you in public.

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Speak No Evil?

I never cease to be amazed at what I read in print and see and hear from the electronic media. In reading my local newspaper last week, I came across a ludicrous tidbit. 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Religion and Politics, Part 1- A Clear Conscience

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Home School Demons

Much has been said in the debate on education about public schooling versus home schooling. The issues range from who is really responsible for the education of children, who can best educate them, and the problem of "socialization" for home schooled children, to name a few. From my experience, the socialization that takes place in school settings is usually a major problem itself.

Concerning the public government school system, much has been said about revamping, restructuring and renewing the system. All such talk is nonsense and misses the mark. To speak of fixing the system is tantamount to arguing over how to repair a watch that has been smashed under the tire of an eighteen wheeler. Replacement is the issue, not repair. And that is exactly what home schooling parents have chosen to do. Replace the broken government school system with an effective system known as home education. Thank God for the freedom parents have to exercise the God given responsibility to educate their children.

However, home education in itself does not guarantee quality education. The quality of education provided in the home will be determined by the education of the parents(to a degree) and their commitment (key word) to providing a God centered, holistic education with a true biblical world view, characterized by consistency. I believe home education is superior to the God-excluding government program offered in the current system. I am a home school parent, so naturally you would not expect me to say anything different. With that said, however, let's be realistic about some "demons" that can appear and hinder or destroy the effectiveness of home education.

(1) Lack of commitment. No one should begin home education unless they are absolutely committed to following through. It may seem like an easy alternative to some who pull their children from school because they are failing. But if they are failing in a public school, and the cause of failure is rooted in lack of commitment from the parents to initially support and assist their children, it will only get worse in home education, because it requires serious dedication.

(2) Not enough structure. I notice a tendency among some home schooling parents to be too laid back. Since home education is not "formal" education (and why shouldn't it be) requirements are sometimes not tough enough(and this can depend of the parents), schedules are not followed, deadlines are not always met

and curriculum not completed.

(3) Lack of accountability. If some deadlines are not met and some requirements not enforced, who is going to know? If a parent tends to be too laid back with not enough structure, always waiting for that "teachable moment", lack of accountability adds to the problem. Teachable moments are a reality and are great, but structure and accountability are "evils" that are necessary. Besides, we don't wait for "eatable" moments and depend on "sleepable" moments, but schedule them.

(4) **Denial of reality**. Though I believe some real learning disabilities exist, they are not near as common as the purveyors of Ritalin would have us believe. But there can be a tendency among home school parents to go in denial about a legitimate problem that may exist, thinking, hoping, and praying that home schooling in and of itself will effect the remedy. Home schooling is superior, but is not a cure-all, fix-all remedy for **real**

processing problems, genuine cases of dyslexia, etc.

(5) **Arrogance**. Here is a demon that Satan can use in a subtle way. "Our home school kids are better than the heathen in public government schools" Actually, home school kids have the same level of depravity as all kids. They are inherently no better than other kids, but certainly have a better opportunity for a superior God centered education and less exposure to ungodliness than kids in government and private so-called Christian schools. Perspective will help keep this demon at bay.
